

HOW TO MEASURE THE LENGTH OF YOUR HORSE'S BACK FOR A BALANCE QUERY

Stand the horse up with both front feet level and square. Find the back of the shoulder blade and mark with chalk or tape (Mark1). Please note: the front of the tape is lined up with the back of the shoulder blade.




Take one foreleg into extension to mimic a stride and mark the position of the back of the shoulder blade as before (Mark 2).



Find the position of the last rib by feeling along the rib cage and mark as before (Mark 3). Please note: the front of the tape marks the line relating to the position of the last rib.





Send three measurements to BALANCE as follows:

Measurement 1. The distance between Mark 1 and Mark 2.

Measurement 2. The distance between Mark 2 and Mark 3.

Measurement 3. The distance between Mark 1 and Mark 3.
